

Biden in Yellowstone Park today to check on stimulus projects

YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK, Wyo. - Vice President Joe Biden is visiting Yellowstone and Grand Canyon national parks over the next two days to check on stimulus-funded projects under way there.

Biden plans to address workers in Yellowstone on Monday. He then heads to the Grand Canyon, where he plans to speak at the South Rim on Tuesday.

Some \$25 million of the \$862 billion stimulus went to construction and maintenance programs in the two parks. The White House says more than 1,000 workers have been a part of 17 projects at Yellowstone and the Grand Canyon.

There are 800 stimulus-funded projects under way this summer at national parks across the country, according to the White House.
