

EPA launches online forum to communicate with public

Dec. 4 -- The U.S. EPA is launching a new online forum to enhance communications with the public.

The new forum, <http://blog.epa.gov/oswerforum/>, will address a variety of environmental topics and ask for feedback from the public.

The first four discussion topics on the new forum pertain to community involvement, Superfund metrics, toxic material reduction and land revitalization. Future topics could include recycling, waste management, brownfields, leaking underground storage tanks and emergency response, according to the EPA.

The EPA plans to post new topics monthly.
