

# ***E. coli found in parts of Glendo State Park***

Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality testing revealed several areas with *E. coli* and other contaminants at Glendo State Park.

The impacted areas are located in “backwater flooded areas,” like Sandy Beach Campground and Whiskey Gulch Boat Ramp. The water in more open water areas like those near Glendo Marina is deemed safe for human contact.

“It may be prudent to inform campers to avoid full body (water) contact activities in the flooded campground areas. Water skiing and swimming in the open lake areas is probably not a concern.” Bill DiRienzo of DEQ said in a letter to the Wyoming Division of State Parks, Historic Sites and Trails,
