

Electronics makers form recycling company

Three electronics manufacturers have formed an electronics recycling company to meet the increasing demand for electronic waste management services.

Electronic Manufacturers Recycling Management Company LLC is a joint venture between Panasonic Corp. of North America, Sharp Electronic Corp. and Toshiba America Consumer Products. Its first mission is provided recycling services to meet requirements under legislation Minnesota recently enacted calling for electronics manufacturers to recycle their products at the end of their lives.

MRM also is planning for recycling programs in other states with and without take-back legislation and is contracting with other electronics manufacturers to provide recycling services.
