

90 Day Interest Free Emergency Loan Application Processed through State  
Associations

As part of the Rural Water Revolving Loan Fund, there is a new provision for a 90 day interest free emergency loan for equipment to bring systems back on line as quick as possible.

This provision is designed specifically for declared national, state or local emergencies and since it would be an emergency the application is expedited by your state Rural Water Association recommending approval.

We realize that, depending on the type of emergency, financial information may not be readily available. However, we have to have some documentation and the Rural Water Association Field Staff should acquire as much as possible to transmit with the application. The documentation in whole or part will facilitate a quick turnaround. Those documents are:

1. Most recent financial audit
2. Most Recent financial budget
3. Most recent income and expense statement
4. Listing and contact information for system officers and board.

Our goal will be to review the emergency application and have the check in the system 's hands within 12-48 hours. In most cases if the information is provided and a wire transfer can be done it will be less than 24 hours.

Contact Wyoming Rural Water for an application and filing information. When the application is received with the State Association's recommendation, we will contact the system directly if other information is needed in order to process the loan and determine how funds should be transferred.

It should be stressed this provision is for declared emergencies and is based on your association's recommendation for funding. A declared emergency may be national, state or local. This provides a great service to your members directly from your association. There is no liability to you or the association. As we promote this provision, we will make it clear it can only be accessed through your office.
