

## Groundwater group presents 2007 awards

WESTERVILLE, OH — The [National Ground Water Association \(NGWA\)](#) recently presented awards to industry achievers during its Ground Water Expo and Annual Meeting, which was held in December in Orlando, FL.

The San Antonio Water System (SAWS) received the 2007 NGWA Outstanding Project in Ground Water Supply Award for “outstanding science, engineering and contractor innovation” regarding its Twin Oaks Aquifer Storage and Recovery Facility, according to a recent NGWA press release.

The NGWA presented Niels Due Jensen, Grundfos Group chairman, with the 2007 Equipment Design Award for excellence in the design of equipment or a product, specifically for the development and introduction of the variable speed pump into the water well industry, NGWA said.

Dr. Edward A. Sudicky, a professor in the University of Waterloo’s (Ontario) Earth Sciences Department, received the 2007 NGWA M. King Hubbert Award for his work in numerical analysis of hydrologic systems.
