

HP to pay consumers for recycling certain items of value

Jan. 6 -- Hewlett-Packard Co. has expanded its electronics recycling program to include a way for consumers to receive cash for equipment with residual value.

Consumers can find out if their product has value by going to HP's Web site and entering in the proper information to receive an instant quote on any brand of unwanted computer, monitor, digital camera, personal digital assistant or smart-phone. If there is residual value, they can send the product back to HP to receive cash back through the HP Consumer Buyback and Planet Partners Recycling Program.

If the product has no value, they can recycle HP and Compaq equipment for free.
