

HP will make computers more energy efficient

Hewlett-Packard Co. will reduce the energy consumption of its desktop and notebook computers by 25 percent by 2010.

The Palo Alto, Calif.-based company unveiled its plan, Jan. 8, during the Consumer Electronics Show in Las Vegas. It plans to reach the goal through several strategies, including installing more energy efficient components, such as power supplies and chipsets.

"HP for decades has been integrating environmentally responsible components and processes across the entire product lifecycle," said Todd Bradley, executive vice president for HP's personal systems group.
