### **Pinedale air quality topic of public meeting tomorrow**

PINEDALE — Oil and gas operators in the Pinedale Anticline will host an educational series tomorrow evening on preserving air quality in the region. Natural resource and environmental specialists from Ultra Petroleum, Shell and Questar will present information about current monitoring activities, emission inventories, emission reduction technologies and efforts to reduce Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) and Nitrogen Oxide (NOx) emissions, as well as ozone contingency plans.

Following the presentation, representatives from the companies will answer audience questions.

This is the second of a three-part series designed to share information about how producers plan on delivering on their commitments to Sublette County, and to discuss topics that are important to the people who live there.
