For its entry, Wyoming will choose the best of the best to represent our state in Washington D.C. at the National Rural Water Rally April 2009.

Wyoming has made an amazing showing the four years we have competed. In 2005, the Town of Afton finished in the top five in the Nation. We could not send a sample in 2006 because Rally was held at the same time as our Spring Conference. They allowed us to send both the 2006 and 2007 winners to Rally in 2007, and both entrants finished in the TOP TEN!

We invite every system attending conference this year to enter **"The Best Tasting Water in Wyoming"** contest. It is as simple as sending a half gallon sample in glass and on ice with any conference attendee. If your system plans to enter, call and let us know, or send an email so we have an accurate count.

The winning system will be hosted (airfare, room and meals for 1 system representative) in Washington, D.C. by Association staff and will meet with Wyoming's federal delegation including meetings at the Senate and House Office buildings, and the US Capitol.
