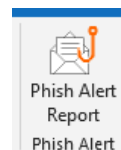

Workshop Description: This workshop conducted by Rocky Mountain Section AWWA and Wyoming Association of Rural Water Systems will provide an overview of AWIA and the steps your utility can take to update its Emergency Response Plan so that it can be prepared.

A key element to being prepared is knowing how to respond to cybersecurity threats. This workshop will feature an interactive Table Top Exercise entitled “**A SUSPICIOUS E-MAIL MESSAGE ARRIVES...**” that will have participants evaluate and respond to a simulated cybersecurity attack. This workshop will include the following elements:

- Review of AWIA requirements, recommendations, and time tables
- Review of the Incident Command System (ISC) for responding to emergency situations
- Building a Human Firewall – A key to defending against cybersecurity threats
- Table Top Exercise: “A SUSPICIOUS E-MAIL MESSAGE ARRIVES...”
