Job Description: Under the supervision of the Chief Plant Operator, Operate and maintain Level 3 Water Treatment Plant. Duties includes operating plant, sampling and laboratory testing for water quality, data entry, performing routine and preventative maintenance, housekeeping, and grounds maintenance, working shifts, week-ends, holidays and being on call as necessary. Must be able and willing to work alone; work around hazardous chemicals, high voltage equipment and working under adverse conditions.

Requirements: Must be self motivated individual. Preference will be given to applicant with a Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality Level 3 or 4 Water Treatment Plant Operators Certification or the ability to obtain Level 3 Certification within an agreed upon time. We will train, if necessary, for certification. Computer experience with Microsoft XL and Word is a plus. Must pass drug screen and physical examination and be able to lift 50 pounds, climb stairs, ladders, and follow protective safety policies and procedures. A probationary period will apply to the successful applicant.
