The City of Laramie is accepting applications for a Utility Maintenance Worker/Operator. Under general supervision, will perform a variety of duties involved in installing, maintaining, repairing, and cleaning facilities involving wastewater treatment, collection, water treatment, distribution, water pumps as well as maintenance, service and repair services; install, test and repair water meters, backflow devices, and meter reading; and to perform other related duties as assigned.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for the maintenance, repair, and operation of the collection, distribution, and meter systems for the water and waste water systems.
- Sit, stand, walk, kneel, crouch, stoop, squat crawl, twist, climb, push, pull, lift 50 pounds, distinguish color, and wear protective apparel.
- Exposure to cold, heat, noise, outdoors, vibration, confining work space, chemicals, explosive materials, mechanical hazards, electrical hazards, toxic substances, tolerate foul odors, wastewater, sludge, effluents, biohazards, and traffic hazards.
- Ability to travel to different sites and locations.
- Available for shift work, on call, stand-by, and emergency call.

EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

- High school diploma or GED. Documentation of high school diploma or GED certificate will be required upon hire.
- Current Wyoming driver license with the ability obtain a Wyoming Class CDL license within 6 months.
- Continued employment is contingent upon all of the following:
 - Obtain class A CDL with tanker endorsement within first 6 months of date of hire.
 - Obtain level I Distribution and level 1 Collections within first 12 months of date of hire.
 - Obtain level II Distribution and level II Collections within first 24 months of date of hire.
